Outline of the project idea	'Delivering Views' is a project for artistic development, aiming at the contact and cultural exchange between countries. To this end, actions like travelling, self-acting and research will constitute the project's main actions that will benefit both participants and places. More specifically, project's participants (e.g. artists, intellectuals) will have the chance to visit a country in order to create any type of artwork like short films, photographs, texts etc. Participants are free to choose the subject (i.e. something interesting to their eyes) and work on it. Hence, the 'Delivering Views' favours the authentic expression and the genesis of contemporary cultural work through the mix of arts, science and technology. Participants get an active role and through their artistic approach they offer new perspectives to the natives by re-approaching and re-interpreting components of the place visited. Project's output will be archived and will be available through the corresponding city libraries in order to be used as research material by readers and scientists. <u>General Objectives</u> The project aims at creativity and cultural development, based on mobility (transnational circulation of works and people) and the use of digital technologies. Such an approach will promote cultural exchanges and the internationalisation of careers. <u>Specific Objectives</u> It is a basic objective to give stimuli for the creation of artwork. Moreover, it is challenging to see common things to somebody's eyes through a new aspect. Our cities are inexhaustible sources of inspiration when it comes to art. The project foresees the identification of the most promising areas of action for each region, the mobilization of the main local stakeholders, and finally the integration of the lessons learnt from these interregional cooperation activities
